AUDIENCE: Consumer, Pharmacy, Veterinary Providers

ISSUE: Wedgewood Pharmacy is conducting a voluntary recall of a sterile compounded veterinary medication, Cyclosporine in Corn Oil 0.2% ophthalmic solution (15 ml, lot 000-00731315). The products were compounded exclusively for the use in animals. There have been no reports of adverse reactions

BACKGROUND: There have been no reports of adverse reactions. However, in an abundance of caution, Wedgewood voluntarily initiated the recall after receiving notification that one of the samples submitted for sterility testing may have been compromised.

RECOMMENDATION: Wedgewood Pharmacy asking all patients and providers that received Cyclosporine in Corn Oil 0.2% ophthalmic solution (15 ml, lot 000-00731315) take the following actions:

- 1. Discontinue use of the medication;
- 2. Quarantine any unused medication;
- 3. Contact us at 1-800-331-8272 to discuss the return of any unused medications;

And

4. If you have dispensed any medications to a patient(s) for further use outside of your office, then you should contact the patient to whom the medication was dispensed and advise the patient(s) of this recall.
