#### **Probation Statistics**

As of December 28, 2020, the Veterinary Medical Board (Board) has 87 licensees on probation. Of these, 72 are veterinarians, and 15 are registered veterinarian technicians (RVTs). We currently do not have anyone who holds a Veterinary Assistant Controlled Substance Permit (VACSP) on probation.

Seven veterinarians and four RVTs are tolling. Pursuant to the Board's Disciplinary Guidelines, tolling occurs due to lack of practice and/or residing in another state. When in tolling status, a probationer does not have to comply with certain conditions of probation. Any time period in tolling status is added to the length of probation. Tolled probationers generally require significantly less monitoring.

The Board has 22 probationers participating in biological fluid testing. We have 100 pending complaints against 29 probationers. We have seven probationers pending at the Office of the Attorney General. The Board sent nine letters regarding compliance concerns to probationers in the last quarter.

#### Staffing Update

As previously mentioned, effective probation monitoring has been a challenge due to the lack of staff resources. As a result, timely logging of compliance documents, immediate response to questions, and regular probation meetings are not always possible. To address this need, the Board has requested a limited-term office technician to assist the probation monitor with the time-consuming technical tasks. These include: scanning and storing documents, processing probation complaints, coding compliance in BreEZe, and performing superficial status checks. This will allow the probation monitor to have more bandwidth to more efficiently monitor the current probationer pool.

## **Probation Monitor Goals**

- Continue case reviews.
- Work the complaints on probationers.
- Find and follow up on any discrepancies in the Biological Fluid Testing program.
- Pursue violations of probation.
