The Board currently has eleven rulemaking packages that are pending in the rulemaking process. Four of those packages are in various stages of the pre-review or initial or phase of the process, as described below and identified in the attached document. The remaining seven packages are pending preparation by Board staff for submission to the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA).

Updates or changes in the status of rulemaking packages since January 2022 are provided below:

Elimination of the California State Board Examination (CSBE), Temporary License, California Curriculum, and Appeals Process of Examination Results— CCR, Title 16, Sections 2010, 2014, 2014.1, 2015, 2015.1, 2015.2, 2016, 2020, Article 2.5 (2021–2021.10) and 2068.6

Update: This Section 100 regulation package has been submitted to DCA for its prereview.

Summary of Proposed Changes: This Section 100 package reflects nonsubstantive, cleanup amendments necessary to align with Assembly Bill (AB) 1535. Specifically, it removes regulatory language related to the CSBE, temporary licenses, California curriculum, and appeals of examination results.

Updated Fees—CCR, Title 16, Sections 2070, 2071, and 2071.1

Update: This Section 100 regulatory package reflects non-substantive, cleanup amendments specific to the fee changes necessary to align with Assembly Bill (AB) 1535. This Section 100 fee package was separated from the above package for ease of tracking purposes. This package was submitted to Office of Administrative Law on April 7.

Summary of Proposed Changes: This proposal would align the Board's fees pursuant to <u>Business and Professions Code section 4905</u>.

Civil Penalties for Citations—CCR, Title 16, Sections 2043

Update: Since the January meeting, Board staff, DCA's Budgets, and DCA's regulations unit have worked together to move this package through the process and it was submitted to DCA for its initial review process on March 25, 2022.

Summary of Proposed Changes: This proposal would permit the Board to issue citations and assess fine for violations that do not occur "while engaged in the practice of veterinary medicine". Such violations include failing to complete continuing education, criminal convictions, and failing to respond to the Board's request for medical records. This proposal enhances the Board's ability to encourage compliance with the Veterinary Medicine Practice Act.

Uniform Standards for Substance-Abusing Licensees—CCR, Title 16, Sections 2006, 2006.5–2006.56

Update: This regulations package implements <u>Article 3.6 Uniform Standards</u> <u>Regarding Substance-Abusing Healing Arts Licensees</u> in the Business and Professions Code. This package was sent to DCA for pre-review on April 1, 2022.

Summary of Proposed Changes: This proposal would establish standards adopted by DCA's Substance Abuse Coordination Committee (SACC). The SACC was established to develop consistent and unform standards for dealing with substanceabusing licensees. The Board adopted standards to be in alignment with other DCA healing arts entities.
